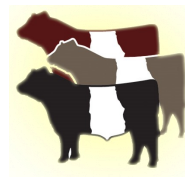

Happy New Year everyone! What an exciting year 2017 projects to be.

Council met by a special teleconference meeting on December 12, 2016. After a lot of deliberation, discussion, and discovery, Council made use of the Long Range Planning Committee's recommendation to register mismarked purebred females in the Herd Book proper. Those females will no longer be recorded in the Appendix. This is a decision I whole heartedly agree with. Mismarked purebred females will continue to have a letter designation following their registration number indicating the type of mismark by the code M1, M2, M3, or M4. Council also approved that the Appendix will remain for percentage cattle. Thank you to all of our members who provided their input, and special thanks to those who diligently processed the information that was provided.

Moving forward, I have asked the Beef Technology and Performance Committee to discuss expanding the DNA database of the Belted Galloway breed and to review broadening the collection of data. I envision this task to be accomplished primarily by the DNA testing of all bulls prior

to registration. The mission statement of the Belted Galloway Society is: *"To promote the Belted Galloway breed of cattle, to preserve the purity of the breed by maintaining pedigree records and data, to disseminate information relative to said breed of cattle and to carry on all legal and proper activities to effectuate the primary purpose of the corporation"*. In keeping with this statement, I believe it is time to increase our efforts to maintain the integrity of the Belted Galloway breed. I think we are at the point where genetic confirmation via DNA testing could be a significant step forward to support the intentions of the founders of the Society.

While the primary concern is to keep costs as low as possible for our membership, we must take advantage of every tool available to improve our ability as producers to be a viable and thriving contributor to the world food supply. The committee will also discuss another aspect of our DNA database, and one that deserves constant discovery and vigilance, hypotrichosis. They will offer their recommendations to Council regarding both of these important issues.

As winter is upon us, as well as tax season, remember tomorrow is always a surprise. Unless of course, you have to pay!

The Southwest Belted Galloway Association Fall Gathering was held in McKinney, Texas in early November. Co-hosting the event were Tom & Judy Shaw of Cardinal Ranch, Leonard, Texas and Chris & Claire Johnson of Buffalo Dream Ranch in southwest Oklahoma.

Two days of southern hospitality began with fine food at a local restaurant in Leonard, Texas. On Saturday morning the group met in an annex of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in McKinney, Texas for a catered breakfast. At the end of breakfast, the attendees were invited by Tom Shaw to introduce themselves and share about their farms or ranches. Highlights included:

Tim Alford (wife Patty and son Michael) from Emory, Texas discussed growing up in a zoo environment. Tim now owns Easy Pickings Farm and raises blueberries, blackberries, chickens, and began a starter herd from Bluebird Ranch.

Joshua and Angela Williams of Gilmer, Texas spoke about their 60-acre ranch and how they started their Beltie with stock from Sharon Adams' Avalon Farms.

Tim and Monica Hughes came to the meeting to get more information about Belted Galloway cattle. They spoke about their 20-acre farm which has a donkey, chickens, and two Herefords.

Gary and Sharon Marshall of Kingsland, Texas said hello to the group. They have an established herd of beautiful Belties.

Bob and Sheri Riley of Blanco, Texas spoke about their six years raising Belties and their herd originated from Dan Roher, Rocky Hills Orchard, Fredericksburg, Texas. They currently have twenty head of cattle and a bull from Scott and Holly Griffith's Bluebird Ranch. They will soon harvest their first steer.

Scott and Holly Griffith of Bluebird Ranch, Murchison, Texas attended. Scott talked about beginning their herd in the early days of their ranch and their continued desire to build better genetics.

Guest speaker Mackenzie Moore, a Rangeland Management Specialist at the USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service, presented the importance of utilizing trusted sources for ranching information. His ideology is that an educated rancher is a better rancher. He provided the group with examples of sources of primary information like the extension service and the Noble Foundation. He also included other informational sources via the web with handouts.

In closing, Chris Johnson of Mountain Park, Oklahoma spoke about the many learning experiences he and his wife Claire have encountered. They have been growing their Belted Galloway herd over the past seven years. He discussed some of Buffalo Dream Ranch's new corral and animal handling systems.

There was a gathering back at the Cardinal Ranch in rural Leonard. The group walked the Cardinal Ranch pastures to look at the herd followed by a delicious meal featuring Beltie Beef chili. Discussions lasted well into the evening while guests were serenaded by coyote calls.

And thank you to all of our customers, especially the juniors, from coast-to- coast that have had confidence in our program."

Over the past 16 years, Sunnybrook Farms produced numerous show animals of the year. They implemented the use of production records, DNA trait identification, and carcass results from ultrasound and slaughter data to further the predictability of the offspring produced in their herd. The awards are now generational. Cattle who have won awards have produced progeny who have continued the tradition of winning the same awards, creating breeding cattle with several generations of predictable performance. The end result is a uniform and consistent calf crop. Our motto "We don't breed show cattle, we show breeding cattle" is very important to us. The Willis family stated, "Being named Breeder of the Year is the ultimate praise for our breeding program!"


