

# US Beltie News



*Jack Bagley, Sperryville, Virginia*

Greetings from the Piedmont region in central Virginia and a farm called the Fields of Athenry located near Sperryville, VA. We are surrounded by the Blue Ridge mountains, the Shenandoah National Park, many Civil War battlefields, the birthplace of eight US Presidents including Thomas Jefferson, James Madison, James Monroe, Woodrow Wilson; the University of Virginia, and thousands of acres of farmland home to cattle, horses, and poultry houses. Two events transpired that resulted in the establishment of the Fields of Athenry and the arrival of Belted Galloways at our new piece of property.

Approximately fifteen years ago, after our sons left “the nest,” we decided to move from the suburbs of Washington to the less crowded countryside. We ended up buying 60 acres near Sperryville, which is about 90 miles west of Washington. The property is in a beautiful setting in the shadow of Old Rag Mountain in the Shenandoah National Park with the Hazel River flowing through our farm.

Having grown up on a dairy farm in Pennsylvania and with a new piece of property, I thought what an opportunity to have a few animals! (I knew dairy cattle were not the answer.) My wife, Delma, and I have taken several vacation trips to Ireland and Scotland. Ireland is the birthplace of our Irish ancestors and is a beautiful land replete with rolling hills occupied by cattle, horses, and sheep. Scotland also is a beautiful country with its native beauty and animals that are not well known in the USA. Since it is the ancestral home of the Belted Galloway breed, I was intrigued with this “Oreo” species and its characteristics.



We came back to Virginia and did some more research and contacted some owners of Belties in our home state. We now had this farm which could accommodate animals. Delma had already purchased a horse, some companion goats for the horse, and a few chickens. Belties fit the criteria for this man with cattle in his background: docile, good mothers, polled, and able to deal with hot and cold temperatures. We visited some of the famous Scottish Beltie breeders such as Mochrum and Park herds.

In 2009, we bought our first two heifers. We now have ten cows. Our business model is to raise the calves for sale as breeding stock for their herds or beef consumption. I also keep a few for replacements.

Over the past few years, I have become active in various Belted Galloway activities. I try to attend the Society Annual meetings; have attended and purchased Belties at several Fryeburg sales; attended the World Congress meeting in Scotland in 2016; am a member of the New England Galloway Group, and I was recently elected to be a member of the Council of the Belted Galloway Society. I enjoy the camaraderie and learning from those who have had Belties for many years. I'm also very supportive of the junior program so that the tradition continues.

The Fields of Athenry is the name of an old Irish ballad and the name of a market town we visited in central Ireland. It is situated in a region like our farm in central Virginia.

## Mandatory Testing Requirements for Bulls

All bulls born on or after January 1, 2018 are required to be DNA and hypotrichosis tested before registration. Fees for the mandatory DNA and hypotrichosis testing are \$65. The Executive Director's office will generate the paperwork for samples to be submitted to UC Davis.

Bulls born on January 1, 2018 or after, may be registered with the CLRC for \$30 *after the DNA and hypotrichosis testing are completed*. Council reduced the registration fee to \$30 for all bulls born on January 1, 2018 or after to accommodate the mandatory testing.

The Executive Director's office will notify the breeder with the test results and an authorization for registration.

Bulls born before January 1, 2018 are not required to be DNA or hypotrichosis tested and fees for registration will remain \$50.

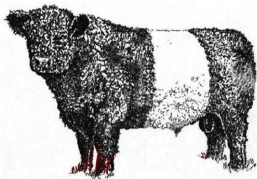
