# COUNCIL ELECTIONS & BALLOT

## **Greg Hipple, Past President**

Council elections will be held during the Annual General Meeting in Louisville, Kentucky. We have three Council seats up for election. Randy Hall (ME) is running for his second term as a member of Council. Sheri Riley (TX) and Victoria Oatley (RI) have been nominated for their first terms. A term consists of two years, and each member of Council may serve two consecutive terms. Our Council works on a volunteer basis. We are very appreciative of these candidate's willingness and dedication to our breed. Regular and Lifetime members are eligible to vote either by mail before the deadline set forth on the ballot below or in person at the Annual General Meeting in Kentucky at the NAILE in November. Each membership number is allowed one vote.

## **RANDY HALL (ME)**

Randy Hall (ME) and his partner, Lori James, with their children Dustin and Meg, raise Belted Galloway and Hereford cattle at Pine View Farm in East Dixfield. Randy began raising Hereford cattle in 1978 and showed Herefords at the national level for many years before making the switch to Belted Galloway cattle in 1998. The herd now consists of approximately 35 head. The family exhibits their Belted Galloways all over the Northeast and as far away as Louisville, Kentucky. Randy is also the co-owner of Hall Farms Organic Dairy, a family tradition currently in its eighth generation. The family has maintained a herd of registered Holstein cattle since 1945, with original farm operations dating back to the early 1800's. In addition to their organic dairy operation, Randy and his brother, Rodney, also produce a large amount of Maine maple syrup, tapping approximately 7,000 trees. Outside of the farm, Randy is very active in the agricultural community. He currently serves a member of the Maine House of Representatives and is past President of the New England Galloway Group, president of the Franklin County Agricultural Society, and recently finished his term as the President of the Maine Agricultural Fair Association. Additionally, Randy also serves as the chief of the local volunteer fire department. Randy is excited about continuing on the Council and looks forward to representing the breed in a professional manner.

## **SHERI RILEY (TX)**

Sheri Riley (TX), has been involved in some aspect of livestock most of her life. While growing up in Houston she was an accomplished horseman and showed Quarter Horses. In 1988 she moved to the small hill country town of Blanco, TX where her family bought 200 acres. At that point her passion for animals of all sorts escalated. Along with her mother and father, the family began an adventure raising ostrich for meat production. At the same time her father became interested in raising llamas, so another adventure began. As the ostrich industry faded, she sold out her operation and concentrated on her llamas, which became the center point of her livestock breeding program. She raised several top 10 and national winners. In 2008 she married Bob Riley and they both became interested in Belties and purchased the beginning of their herd. They have been actively breeding and improving their small herd of around 25 head for the past 10+ years. Since expanding the herd, they have produced several show quality animals and have become active in showing in the Texas region. Sheri has been instrumental in starting new shows and getting Beltie classes in the Texas region and has hosted

several Beltie events and field days. She and Bob always enjoy visiting with newcomers to the breed and love promoting it. She is currently the Treasurer for the Southwest Belted Galloway Association, and also serves on the Chatfield Scholarship Committee for the Society.

In addition to managing their Beltie herd, the Riley's own and operate three B&B's in Fredericksburg, TX. She and Bob are also antique dealers and enjoy going to auctions and estate sales. Sheri is also quite active in her church and serves on their council as the financial Secretary.

## **VICTORIA OATLEY (RI)**

Victoria first gained experience with Belties when her grandfather Vernon Oatley managed the show string for Anderson Hill Farm, in Rutland, VT. She tagged along with her family when they showed the cattle at Eastern States and at the NAILE. These shows are where she met the Prock's of Prock Ridge Farm.

In 1998, at six-years-old, she was given the opportunity to show one of the Prock's heifers in showmanship. This was her first time showing a Belted Galloway at Eastern States. A few years later, Lorraine Prock and her daughter, Lori Guptil persuaded her to put in an application for the Heifer Project. Later that fall, to her surprise, she was awarded a heifer named Spurwink Magnolia. Victoria didn't know it then, but Magnolia would change her life forever as she was the foundation of her Belted Galloway Herd today. Currently, the Oatley family keep 40 head of cattle on their farm.

Victoria appreciates these cattle for their longevity and fleshing ability. She strives to better her herd and the breed. She believes educating the youth involved in the breed to be extremely vital for it's future. She is an active member of the NEGG where she is the Belted Galloway youth coordinator. Victoria credits the NEGG heifer project and the many people who helped her, that allow her the opportunities she has today.
