I became involved with Belted Galloway cattle in the late '90s when my children were entering 4-H, and we purchased our first heifers to show. My family showed cattle for many years: locally, at World Beef Expo in Milwaukee, Wisconsin and at the North American in Louisville, Kentucky. My husband, David, was a director in the Great Lakes Belted Galloway Association, and I began doing their newsletter in 1999.

In the fall of 2001, Marlin Sherbine, then president of the Belted Galloway Society, called me and said that Jane Faul, from Battletown, Kentucky was retiring as editor of the *US Beltie News*. He asked if I would I be interested in that role? I accepted the position, and for several years did both newsletters.

The backstory of the *US Beltie News* is that it evolved into a monthly publication during the mid '80's when past president Al and Dorothy Tietig, began sending members sporadic letters recapping each year's events. The membership passed the 150 mark in 1989, and it was no longer possible for the membership to personally mentor each new member. The goals of the newsletter were to pass along tips, breed data, health information, ads, and event news. Andy LeMaistre, Freeport, Maine who was serving as president at the time, was instrumental in establishing the monthly newsletter.

The newsletter has undoubtedly grown in these 30 years from a single two-sided sheet to an eight-page monthly. We are regularly challenged trying to fit everything in. For many years, the Society didn't have the funds to print the newsletter in color. Finally, in 2014 the Society was able to send it to print in color.

Announcing my retirement from the *US Beltie News* is bitter-sweet. I have had the opportunity to meet many wonderful breeders and view some of the best cattle in the breed. I've thoroughly enjoyed working with the membership, serving on Council and various committees, writing for the Journal, overseeing beltie.org, and working with Executive Director Vic Eggleston. For the remaining part of 2019, I will be working behind the

scene, helping with the transition.

My family has been reminiscing and talking about our years in the breed. My 21-year-old son, Ryan, told me that he doesn't remember his life without his mom working on a Belted Galloway publication. My husband, David, recalled all the presidents that I have worked with. My older children, Ross and Rachel, hope their boys will show Belted Galloway cattle in the future. I am certainly pleased that the Belted Galloway breed influenced their love of agriculture and their careers within the ag industry. Our Wayside Valley pastures will continue to have Belted Galloway cattle grazing in them.



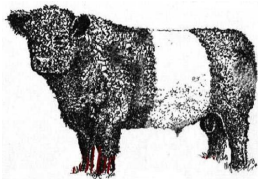
