This also means that many of our members, including Juniors, are getting ready for the Belted Galloway Open and Junior Shows. We have approximately 80 entries That is a very good indication of the interest by our members in showing their animals notwithstanding the protocols that will be in place at the location.

The Open Show is Thursday, November 18th at 8AM.**

For those who will be in Louisville, the Annual Meeting will be Wednesday, November 17th at the Crown Plaza Hotel near and the Exposition Center. For those who cannot attend in person, we hope to be able to have a telephone connection **1-888-346-3659, pass code 15912 at 7:30PM EST.** For those planning on attending there will be a reception at the hotel starting at 6PM followed by a dinner and guest speaker (Warren Beeler, Former Director of Agriculture Policy at Kentucky Dept. of AG) sponsored by the Society after which will be the business meeting.

Speaking of meetings, the Council met via Zoom on October 20th to consider a full agenda. The Council approved the Minutes of the July 20th meeting. These minutes are

Jon Bednarski (KY) gave a summary of the Advertising Committee's activities. The major item was a commitment by the Society to purchase a full page ad in an upcoming issue (February) of Hobby Farms which will highlight the Belted Galloway breed. For those of you are not Hobby Farm subscribers, there will be copies available in Tractor Supply stores.

Aileen Tarap (CA) gave a report on her efforts to raise funds to support the Scholarship Fund for the Juniors. It raised \$3500 for our Juniors.

Victoria Oatley (RI) gave a report on her research on recording heifers born to registered dams and solid colored polled beef sires. (Copies of Victoria's presentation are available on the website.)

Pat Hipple (IA) and Paul Tarap (CA) provided a report on the issue of showing unregistered Belties at BGS sponsored shows.

Effective January 1st, 2022, no Beltie will receive show points if it is not registered when it is shown regardless of whether the show is sponsored. Sponsored shows will not receive BGS funding if it allows a non-registered belties to show.

Sheri Riley (TX) provided a summary of the results of the recent show at the American Royal in Kansas City where there were 40 entries. Randy Hall (ME) did the same for

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE CONTINUED...

...the recent show at the annual Fryeburg Fair where there 63 entries.

I gave an update on status of the Junior Program since the resignation of Janie Tripp (MS) as Chair of the Juniors Program. Dustin James (ME) is continuing as Co-Chair until the Annual Meeting at which time Committee Chairs and membership of those Committees will be discussed. Dustin James provided the Council with a set of recommendations that would encourage more participation in Belted Galloway activities by Juniors.

There was also some discussion about the situation surrounding the position of Past President (Janie Tripp (MS) served as Past President until her resignation) since that person sits on the Council as a member of the Executive Committee. A motion was made to appoint a replacement for the vacant Past President position on the Council. The Motion was briefly discussed with a split vote on the proposal, but the President observed that the Society's by laws do not address such a vacancy in mid term, and this situation had never occurred in the past. Thus, this item will be discussed at the Annual Meeting as part of the by laws review that was initiated earlier in 2021.

Vic Eggleston (WI) discussed the need to establish an export database for members of the Society that have semen and embryos available for export to breeders in foreign countries.
